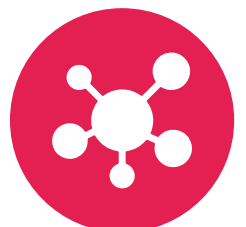

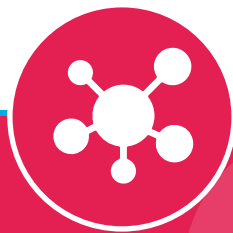
The Dorset Innovation Hub aims to encourage and support the adoption of innovation that meets the needs of the population and develops a culture of innovation.
